Important Information in Response to Federal Immigration Actions

Dear EBAC Community,

As many of you know, federal immigration actions are increasing in the Bay Area.

We want to acknowledge the intensity, anxiety, and fear that many people are experiencing right now. At EBAC, we stand with families and community partners in affirming that all members of our community deserve to feel safe and supported.

EBAC Promises:

- We do not share client information with immigration enforcement agencies.
- All families, regardless of immigration status, language, or background, are welcome to receive services and support at EBAC.
- EBAC follows safety and emergency guidance from local school districts, cities, and Alameda County to keep our spaces secure. Immigration enforcement is not allowed onto sites unless they have a warrant signed by a judge.

We are committed to supporting our staff and families by providing accurate information from trusted sources.
